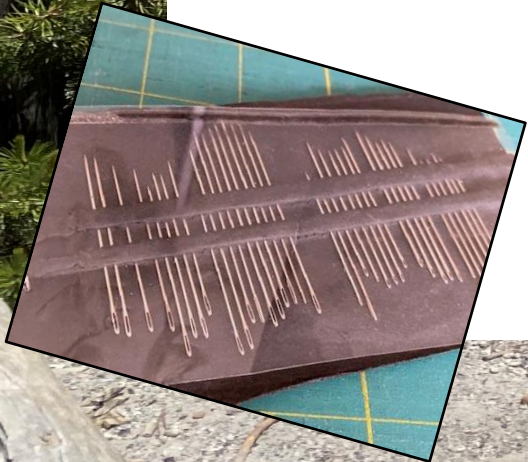
Basic Supplies

- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
For cutting post card blanks and fusible web
- Scissors
For cutting fabrics for imagery
- Iron & pressing surface
For fusing images to post card blanks



Basic Supplies

- Sewing machine or hand-sewing needle
- Thread for quilting
- Pencil or other marking device for placement (optional)
- Glue if not using fusible



Postcard Supplies

- Double-sided Fusible Stiff Interfacing (Fast2Fuse, Timtex, Peltex, etc.) Cut to postcard size – 4"x6", 5"x7", 6"x9", etc.



Postcard Supplies

- Assorted fabric scraps (helps if they're backed with fusible)
- Desired State-



Postcard Supplies

- Actual State-



Postcard Finishing Supplies

- Single piece of fabric for the back side cut to the same size as your foundation
- Binding fabric pre-fused (I prefer Steam-A-Seam 2 for the binding) and cut to $5/8$ " wide by the perimeter of your foundation + 1"



Optional Embellishments

- Crystals
- Beads
- Buttons
- Fabric Paints, inks or markers
- Floss or specialty threads

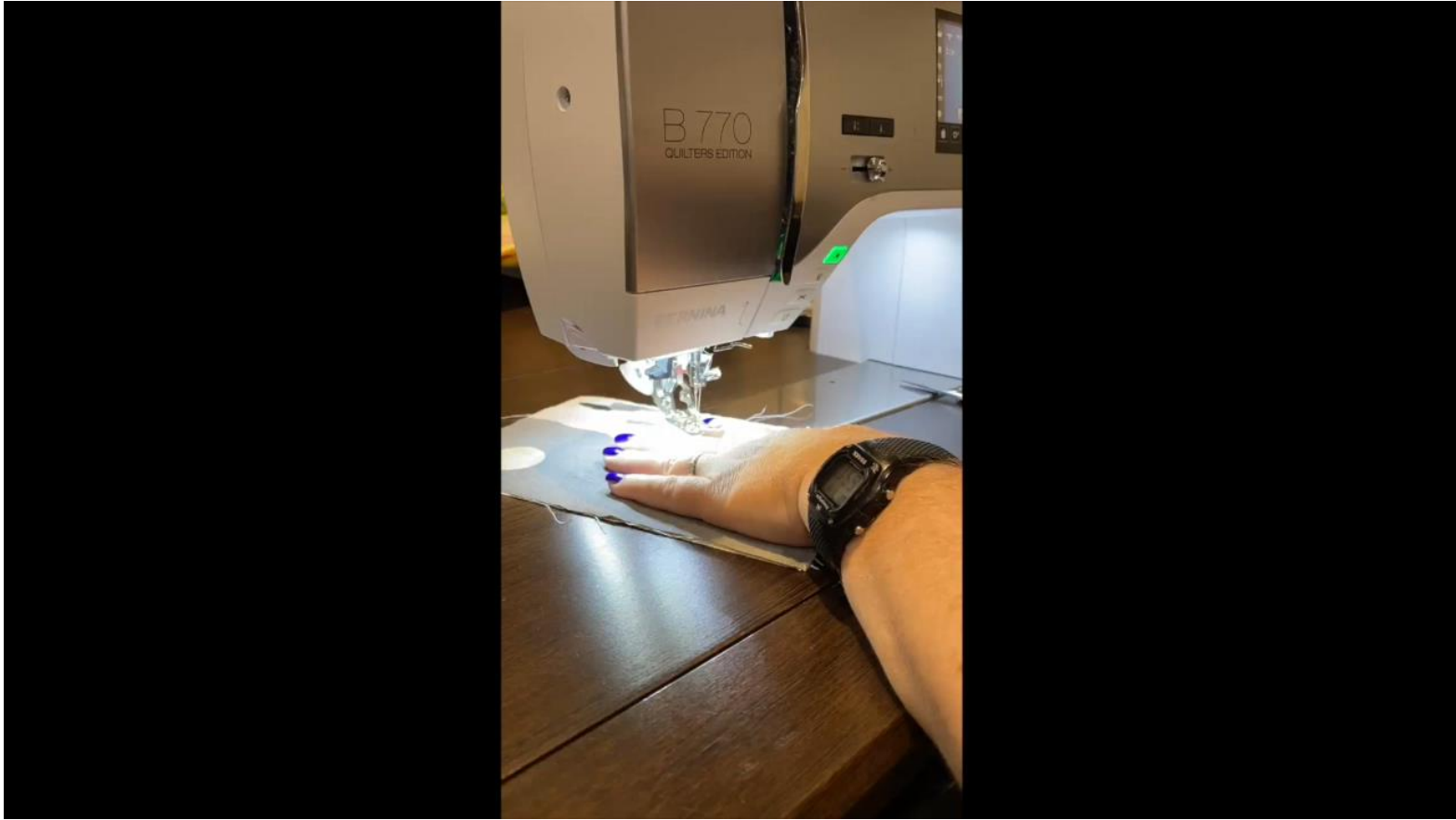
